All Nominees must be WCMA members.

4. **Award Categories and Eligibility**

The *Award for Excellence* recognizes an outstanding administrator or manager who has enhanced the effectiveness of local elected officials and consistently initiated creative and successful programs. Two Awards for Excellence will be made; one to a member with a jurisdiction greater than 5,000 and one to a member whose jurisdiction is less than 5,000.

The *Assistant Excellence in Leadership Award* recognizes the contributions of local government professionals who serve as assistants to chief local government administrators/managers and who have made significant contributions toward excellence in leadership.

The *Award for Skill in Intergovernmental Cooperation* recognizes a member who has demonstrated significant success in representing his or her local government=s policies at the state and/or federal level in such a way that regulatory relief is granted or legislative change is effected or recognizes a member who has demonstrated significant success in establishing a working relationship with the county, state, or federal level in such a manner that enables the local jurisdiction to better serve its citizens.

The *Program Excellence Award for Innovations in Local Government Management* recognizes a local government that has successfully applied the concepts of reinventing, reengineering, total quality management, customization, or other cutting-edge organizational tool. Applications may include, but are not limited to, programs involving intergovernmental relations.
